FARMER SCRIPTING THE SUCCESS IN VALUE ADDITION OF GARCINIA FRUIT




- Kudupuli or Malabar tamarind (Garcinia gummigutta), a wild & shade tree grown in Coffee estate
- The fruits are rich in Hydroxy citric acid, which is an excellent deworming and anti-obesetic properties
- The dried fruit rind and vinegar (Kachampuli) are used in local cuisine preparation
- A matured tree bears100-120 kg fruit.
- From 25 kg fruit, prepare one lt. of vinegar
- The vinegar sells Rs. 700-800 per lt. in the market
- Cost of production: About Rs. 200-250 per lt.
